

How to get to the conference venue

Local buses are a good way to get to the conference venue. Buses frequently depart from JR Nara and Kintetsu Nara stations, and the fare is JPY 200. Taxis are also available from the two stations. It takes around 30 minutes to walk from JR Nara station to the venue; on the way, you will see a lot of temples and deer.

Bus Route 1


JR Nara Sta. (JR奈良) → Kintetsu Nara Sta. (近鉄奈良) → Kenshinkokaido (県新公会堂)

The nearest bus stop to the conference venue is "Kenshinkokaido". There are three or four buses going to the nearest stop every hour.

Bus Route 2

JR Nara Sta. (JR奈良) → Kintetsu Nara Sta. (近鉄奈良) → Daibutsuden Kasugataisha-mae (大仏殿春日大社前)

The second nearest bus stop is "Daibutsuden Kasugataisha-mae", which is a 3 min. walk from the venue. Buses going to this stop depart every 10 minutes.




JR Nara Station → Kintetsu Nara Station → Conference Venue

Taxi 5 min (~JPY 800) Bus 8 min Walk 20 min

Taxi 10 min (~JPY 1,100) Bus 13 min Walk 30 min

How to distinguish between bus Route 1 and Route 2

All buses departing from bus stop No. 1 at either station go to “Kenshinkokaido” (Route 1) or “Daibutsuden Kasugataisha-mae” (Route 2). You can distinguish between Route 1 and 2 from the destination (and car No.).



Boarding a bus: Take a numbered ticket from the ticket printer when you get on a bus, and then pay JPY 200 and give the ticket when you get off the bus.

When you want to get off: When you hear the name of your stop announced, press one of the stop buttons located near your seat.

Bus Route 3

Todaiji Daibutsuden
 Kokuritsuhakubutukan
 (東大寺大仏殿国立博物館)
 → Kintetsu Nara Sta.
 (近鉄奈良)
 → JR Nara Sta.
 (JR奈良)

Buses going to the stations depart from “Todaiji Daibutsuden Kokuritsuhakubutukan” every 5 minutes.
